

Trailer Socket Tester 13pin

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Connect the 13pin plug to the vehicle socket to be tested.
- 2. Take the tester and sit in the Driver's seat of the vehicle.
- 3. The 12v light indicates the tester is correctly connected.
- 4. Press the TEST button and all of the LEDs will light to confirm all are working.
- 5. Switch on the Ignition and test the lights in the normal way.
- 6. The individual LEDs will light when the appropriate vehicle controls are operated.
- 7. This confirms the correct operation of the towing electrics fitted to the vehicle.

NB: On some vehicles with a CAN BUS system the LEDs may flicker – This does not indicate a fault therefore continue testing.
